Thinking of investing in a horse? Here are some average ownership costs.

Fixed Costs	Monthly Investment
Board	\$720
Shoeing (assuming no special needs, every 4-6 weeks)	\$160
Orchard hay and blanketing	\$90
Full training includes groom service	\$1115
Insurance (depending on value of horse) show clips (optional)	TBD
Total Cost	\$2085

Variable Costs	Investment
Vet Bills-routine shots and worming every 6 months	\$50 (every 6 months)
Medication (routine-Banamine given at shows)	\$60 (per show)
Adequine/Legend (given before shows or monthly)	\$200 (per show or monthly)
Medical insurance (depending on value of horse)	TBD
